2. If guests require assistance or care (such as pushing a wheelchair, assistance with dressing or assistance with walking), they must travel with a companion capable of providing the required assistance or care. APT is unable to assist any passenger with walking any transportation vehicles (including river and ocean cruise ships and trains).
